### WHAT DOES ROCKLAND TRUST DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

#### Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

#### What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- Account balances and transaction history
- Payment history and credit scores

#### How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons that Rockland Trust chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

**What We Do**

<b>How does Rockland Trust protect my personal information?</b>	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to guard personal information.

<b>How does Rockland Trust collect my personal information?</b>	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● open an account or make deposits or withdrawals</li> <li>● apply for a loan or apply for insurance</li> <li>● seek advice about your investments</li> </ul> <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>

<b>Why can't I limit all sharing?</b>	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes — information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>● affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>● sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state laws.</p>

<b>What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?</b>	In that case, your choice will apply to everyone on your account — unless you tell us otherwise.

**Definitions**

<b>Affiliates</b>	Our affiliates include those companies that control, are controlled by, or are under common control with Independent Bank Corp or Rockland Trust Company. They can be financial or non-financial companies.

<b>Nonaffiliates</b>	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <i>Rockland Trust does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i></li> </ul>

<b>Joint marketing</b>	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <i>Our joint marketing partners include the credit card company that provides our jointly branded card.</i></li> </ul>
